## **Danish Software House Trifork First in Europe with J2EE™ 1.4 Compatibility**

Trifork will once again be one of the first companies in the world to be Java 2 Enterprise Edition compatible with its application server software product, Trifork T4, and the very first European company to be certified according to the new standard. Trifork will soon provide application servers based on J2EE 1.4.

Obtaining J2EE 1.4 compatibility required the review of 23,752 tests as well as intimate knowledge of some 7,000 pages of technical specifications. "While going through this has been a significant investment, our history shows that the effort is worthwhile," says Trifork CEO, Jørn Larsen. "J2EE 1.4 compatibility will now lead Trifork's next-generation application server, Trifork T4, being launched onto the market."

"J2EE compatibility represents an automatic approval of our company and shows that we are still leading the way with regard to application servers based on Java technology. It is important for us because we are competing with some major players; compatibility puts us on an equal footing in the battle for market share," says Mads Skak Olufsen, Trifork's director of sales.

"It is important for our customers that we can offer application servers with J2EE compatibility. The extensive, community reviewed specifications and rigorous testing via the compatibility test suite together provide a high degree of built-in assurance for those deploying mission critical applications on our J2EE compatible technology," says Mads Skak Olufsen.

In alignment with the J2EE 1.4 specification requirements Trifork's product line of application servers has now been extended with web services, and several other new standards that make it possible for systems based on different languages, technologies, and platforms to be integrated. It will simplify the development process and the installation of complicated enterprise applications.

Two years ago, when the J2EE 1.3 standard was launched, Trifork was also among the first vendors to be able to provide a J2EE compatible product. Subsequently, ten other companies around the world were certified. The majority, eight out of fourteen, were US companies.
