In order to clarify the intellectual property rights granted by the United States Government ("Government") for contributions of software, documentation or any other material to either a product or project owned or managed by Sun Microsystems, Inc. (collectively "Project"), Sun needs to receive a copy of this Open Source Software License Agreement ("Agreement") signed by the Government to indicate the Government's acceptance of the terms below.

1. Contribution means any source code, object code, patch, tool, sample, graphic, specification, manual, documentation, e-mail, comment, posting, communication or any other material posted or submitted by the Government to a Project.

2. The Government hereby grants to Sun a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide, no-charge, royalty-free, unrestricted license to exercise all rights under all worldwide common law and statutory rights associated with the copyrights, copyright applications and copyright registrations in the Government's Contribution, including sublicensing those rights to third parties through multiple tiers of sublicensees or other licensing mechanisms at Sun's option. The Government agrees never to assert against Sun or its licensees or transferees any moral rights the Government has in the Government's Contribution. Any Contribution that Sun subsequently makes available under any license will also be made available under a suitable FSF- or OSI-approved license.

3. The Government hereby grants to Sun, and to any party who receives the Government's Contribution, a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, worldwide, no-charge, royalty-free, license under any patents owned or licensable by the Government at any time without payment to third parties, to make, have made, use, sell, offer to sell, import and otherwise transfer the Government's Contribution in whole or in part, alone or in combination with or included in any product, work or materials arising out of the Project to which the Government's Contribution was submitted, and to sublicense the foregoing rights to third parties through multiple tiers of sublicensees or other licensing mechanisms at Sun's option.

4. The Government retains all right, title and interest in and to the Government's Contribution and may use the Government's Contribution for any purposes. The assignment and licenses granted above are effective on the date the Government first submitted a Contribution to a Project, even if such submission preceded the date below. This Agreement shall be governed by applicable federal law, except where applicable federal law is not dispositive, then the laws of the State of California, without application of choice of law rules.

5. The Government represents that to the best of its knowledge the Government's Contribution is an original work of the Government or of a Government contractor, and that the Government is legally entitled to grant the rights and privileges conveyed by this Agreement. The Government warrants that the Government's Contribution, to the best of the Government's knowledge, does not violate any other party's copyrights, trademarks, patents or other intellectual property rights. This Agreement must be signed by a duly authorized employee of the Government.
